

Added Land Procedures

Added Land is defined as cropland acreage (regardless of crop) added to the insured person's farming operation within the county for the current crop year.

A producer may add up to 640 acres of cropland acreage to an existing Basic/Optional Unit or as a separate Optional Unit **without** an RMA RO review and receive the Simple Average (SA) T-yield.

If the producer adds 640 or more acres, but less than 2000, and the SA T-yield is requested, an RMA RO Review is required. The deadline for requesting an Added Land Review is the Acreage Reporting Date.

Required information for the RMA Added Land Review is:

- RMA Added Land Request Form
- APH for current year
- Cropland Acres
- APH Documentation from previous operator/tenant if applicable
- Aerial photo copies and complete legal descriptions

All documentation listed above must be forwarded to the appropriate regional Underwriting office (Fargo or Raleigh). Underwriting will review the request and submit to the RMA Regional Office.

2000 acres or more added to the farming operation within the county will use variable T-yield guidelines.

The insured must request the Simple Average on the Acreage Report. The request indication will preprint on the form with a "Yes" response. The producer's signature is agreement with the request.
